STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Reciprocal Benefit Arrangements Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 5, sub-§ XII, amended. The 2nd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of subsection XII of section 5 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed, as follows:

'To the extent permissible under the laws and constitution of the United States, the commission is authorized to enter into or cooperate in arrangements whereby facilities and services provided under this chapter and facilities and services provided under the unemployment compensation or employment security laws of any foreign government, may be utilized for the taking of claims and the payment of benefits under the provisions of this chapter, or under a similar law of such government.'
