**AN ACT Relating to Acceptance of Outside Funds for Labor and
Industry Research and Statistics.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 30, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the 1st sentence, two new sentences to read as follows:

'The commissioner is authorized and empowered, subject to the approval of the Governor and the Council, to accept from any other agency of government, individual, group or corporation such funds as may be available in carrying out the provisions of this section, and meet such requirements with respect to the administration of such funds, not inconsistent with the provisions of this section, as are required as conditions precedent to receiving such funds. An accounting of such funds and a report of the use to which they were put shall be included in the biennial report to the Governor.'
