STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Sick Leave for Members of Fire Department of City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows.

- P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XII, § 3-A, additional. Article XII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 3-A, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 3-A. Sick leave. Members of the fire department shall be allowed to accumulate 1½ days of sick leave per month worked, a total of 18 days per year, accumulating to 70 days. At the termination of the employment of the member, he shall have no claim, monetary or other compensation, for any unused portion of days allowed for sick leave.'
