## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Train Order Line-Ups for Railroad Track Motor Cars.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 46, § 74-A, additional. Chapter 46 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 74-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 74-A. Use of train order line-ups for railroad track motor cars. Every person, firm or corporation operating or controlling any railroad running through or within the State shall be required to have train dispatchers issue complete information on all train movement for stated period and specified territory to all motor car operators prior to daily operation of each car. Any person, firm or corporation violating this section shall be punished by a fine of \$100 for each violation.'
