IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Compensation for Members of Maine Employment Security Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 29, § 4, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 4 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 7 of chapter 473 of the public laws of 1955 and by section 8 of chapter 418 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:
 - **'II. Salaries.** The chairman of the commission shall receive a fixed weekly salary, at the rate of \$9,000 \$10,000 per year, and each of the other members shall receive a fixed weekly salary, at the rate of \$8,450 \$9,500 per year, and shall be paid from the Employment Security Administration Fund.'
