STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT to Clarify Appointments under Charter of City of Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1957, c. 169, Art. VIII, § 5, amended. Section 5 of Article VIII of chapter 169 of the private and special laws of 1957 is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Term of office, officers, boards. All officials, officers, trustees, members of commissions or departments now in office holding positions hereafter to be filled under the provisions of this charter by the city council or the city manager shall not serve out their present terms but shall continue in office only until their successors are appointed or elected and qualified as provided in this act. No provision of this act shall be held to modify the terms of the trustees of the Augusta Water District, including present incumbents or their successors in office of the trustees of the Augusta Water District, the members of the Augusta Parking District, the commissioners of the Augusta Sewerage District and the board of commissioners of police of said city, including present incumbents and their successors in office, the charters and functions of said districts and board being hereby confirmed.'
