STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Erection of Signs Designating Accommodations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 149-A, amended. The last paragraph of section 149-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 419 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'In the absence of a specific recreational area, the State Highway Commission on the state constructed and maintained interstate system and the Maine Turnpike Authority on the highways constructed by said authority may shall erect, situated near an exit, suitable signs at the exit designating mote', hotel and restaurant areas.'
