RESOLVE, Providing a Pension for Antoinette Bergeron of Lewiston.

Antoinette Bergeron; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$60 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Antoinette Bergeron, of Lewiston, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Bergeron is 59 years of age. She is ill and unable to work.
