AN ACT Authorizing Railway Express Agency, Inc. to Transport by Truck.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 48, § 28-A, additional. Chapter 48 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 28-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 28-A. Railway Express Agency, Inc. authorized to transport by truck. The Railway Express Agency, Inc., a foreign express company registered with the Secretary of State under chapter 53 to engage in, or transact in this State, the business of transporting by railroad freight, merchandise or other property for compensation, is authorized, subject to the authority of the Public Utilities Commission, to transport such freight, merchandise or other property by such motor vehicles as are licensed by the commission to transport freight or merchandise for hire upon the public highways of this State.’
