RESOLVE, in Favor of Millicent N. Mann and Aetna Insurance Company.

Millicent N. Mann and Aetna Insurance Company; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,061.38 to be paid to Millicent N. Mann and Aetna Insurance Company to reimburse said parties, as their interests may appear, for damage sustained as the result of a collision between the 1957 Lincoln automobile of said Millicent N. Mann and a buck deer on November 16, 1958, at Rumford, Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At about 9 o'clock in the evening of November 16, 1958, Mrs. Mann's car, a 1957 Lincoln convertible, operated by her son, W. Kent Mann, was travelling south on Route 2 in the Town of Rumford, at a modest rate of speed, when a buck deer appeared very suddenly in the highway, directly ahead of the car, and the collision occurred. The driver had no chance to avoid the accident. The cost of repairing the damage to Mrs. Mann's car was \$1,061.38.
