STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Bumpers on Commercial Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 41-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 41-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 41-A. Bumpers on commercial vehicles. All commercial vehicles shall be equipped with bumpers on the front and the rear so arranged and designed that contact between a passenger vehicle and said bumpers will not result in damage to said passenger vehicle.'
