RESOLVE, in Favor of Axel Nelson of Thomaston.

Axel Nelson; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$280.36 to be paid to Axel Nelson, of Thomaston, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of a cow and calf caused by improper tuberculosis testing.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The death of the cow and calf was caused by improper tuberculosis testing and negligence on the part of the tester.
