STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Non-lapsing Funds of Present Biennium for Armory Repairs and Expansion.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the projects authorized by the 98th Legislature to repair and expand certain armories are not in process due to the fact that federal funds, although appropriated, are not yet available; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that the following legislation be enacted to prevent the lapsing of the various appropriations; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1957, c. 195, § 1, Title Section A, amended. That part of Title Section A of section 1 of chapter 195 of the private and special laws of 1957, under caption "ADJUTANT GENERAL, DEPARTMENT OF," is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The appropriation for the expansion of the South Portland Armory shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until its purpose has been accomplished.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1957, c 195, § 2, Title Section B, amended. That part of Title Section B of section 2 of chapter 195 of the private and special laws of 1957, under caption "ADJUTANT GENERAL, DEPARTMENT OF," is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'All of these appropriations shall not lapse, but shall remain continuing carrying accounts until the purposes of the appropriations have been accomplished.'

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
