IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Establishing Disability Due to Radioactive Properties as an Occupational Disease.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 69, amended. Section 69 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 295 and by section 1 of chapter 391 both of the public laws of 1955, is further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

- '17. Disability due to radioactive properties of substances or exposure to ionizing radiation. 17. Any process involving the use of or direct contact with radiation or radioactive substances or the use of or direct exposure to Roentgen rays (X-rays) or ionizing radiation.'
