#### **AN ACT Permitting Certain Trailers and Truck Tractors on Four-lane Highways.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ III, amended.** The 6th paragraph from the end of subsection III of section 16 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 308 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'Only one trailer or semi-trailer shall be drawn by a motor vehicle, **except that on a four-lane divided highway a combination of straight truck and four-wheel trailer or a truck tractor, semi-trailer and four-wheel trailer may be permitted not to exceed 90 feet in length.** All vehicles so used shall be equipped with adequate brakes on all axles and adequate coupling devices in accordance with Interstate Commerce Commission safety regulations.'
