HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 841, L. D. 1192, Bill, "An Act  
Authorizing Red Blinker Light for Volunteer Fire  
Department Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated  
"Sec. 144-A" and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 144-A. Signal lights for volunteer fire departments  
authorized. When authorized by the municipal officers of a munici-  
pality, a red blinker or flashing red signal light, not more than  
5 inches in diameter, may be mounted as near as practicable above  
the registration plate on the front of a motor vehicle operated by  
a volunteer fire department. Such light may be displayed while  
such vehicle is in use for fire or other emergency service. No  
volunteer fireman shall display a red blinker or flashing red  
signal light upon such motor vehicle, except while actually enroute  
to the scene of a fire or other emergency requiring his services  
and unless he shall be an active member of such department. Any  
person displaying a red blinker except when actually enroute to the  
scene of a fire or other emergency shall be punished by a fine of  
\$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 10 days, or by both."
