STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Authorizing Red Blinker Light for Volunteer Fire Department Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 22, § 144-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 144-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 144-A. Signal lights for volunteer fire departments authorized. A red blinker or flashing red signal light, not more than 5 inches in diameter, mounted as near as practicable above the registration plate on the front of a motor vehicle operated by a volunteer fire department may be displayed while such vehicle is in use for fire or other emergency service. No volunteer fireman shall display a red blinker or flashing red signal light upon such motor vehicle, except while actually enroute to the scene of a fire or other emergency requiring his services and unless he shall be an active member of such department.'
