STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Affecting Certain Statutes Relating to Court Process and Procedure and to Kindred Matters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Revised Statutes amended. The Revised Statutes of 1954, as amended, are amended in all respects necessary or appropriate in connection with the promulgation of the proposed Rules of Civil Procedure by the Supreme Judicial Court under its authority granted by the Public Laws of 1957, chapter 159, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, repealing expressly or otherwise amending those statutes superseded or affected in whole or in part by such rules, changing statutory language to conform to that of such rules, modifying and amending various substantive and jurisdictional provisions affected by or relating to such rules, amending said Public Laws of 1957, chapter 159, to change "6 months" in the 3rd sentence to read "not less than 6 months", and clarifying the power of the Supreme Judicial Court to amend such rules subsequent to their promulgation.
