STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Retirement Benefits for Inland Fish and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 6, sub-§ IV, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection IV of section 6 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:

'C. The total amount of the service retirement allowance of a member retired in accordance with paragraph A ~~of this subsection~~ shall be equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ of his average final compensation, or, if retirement occurs at or after the attainment of age 60, equal to the amount of his total service retirement allowance as determined in accordance with subsection II ~~of this section~~, if greater, **except that such retirement benefit shall be not less than \$150 per month for any such member of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game who is married and not less than \$110 per month for any member who is unmarried or a widower, having retired since May 1, 1940 and having had at least 10 years of total creditable service with the department.'**
