AN ACT Relating to State Owned Automobiles for Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15-A, § 43, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 43 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 and as amended by section 12 of chapter 429, both of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

‘This shall not apply to the Governor, the State Police, **State Liquor Inspectors**, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries, supervising state fire inspectors, the Department of State, supervisors in the Maine Forestry District, the State Highway Commission nor to such other agencies, boards, commissions and departments of the State Government as the Governor and Council may from time to time designate.’
