STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Reciprocity in Registration for Motor Vehicles of Residents of Foreign Countries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 68, amended. Section 68 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 68. "Nonresident" defined. The term "nonresident," as used in this chapter, shall be defined as any person whose legal residence is in some state, district or country other than Maine; but a. A nonresident, having a regular abode or place of business or employment within the State for more than 6 3 months of the 12 months next preceding, shall be deemed a resident as to all vehicles principally used in connection with such abode or place of business; and the secretary of state, for the purposes of registration, shall determine what vehicles are so used for the purposes of registration of motor vehicles and operators' licenses.'
