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**AN ACT Increasing Members of Planning Board of City of Belfast.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**P. & S. L., 1929, c. 115, Art. VI, § 11, repealed and replaced.** Section 11 of article VI of chapter 115 of the private and special laws of 1929 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof :

‘Sec. 11. City planning board. The city planning board shall consist of 5 members to be elected by the city council, each to serve 3 years. At its first meeting in March 1960, or as soon thereafter as may be, the city council shall elect 3 members; one for a term of one year, one for a term of 2 years and one for a term of 3 years, and annually thereafter there shall be elected by the city council 2 members of the city planning board for a term of 3 years. The 2 members of the present city planning board whose terms do not expire in 1960 shall continue to hold office until their terms expire. If for any reason a vacancy occurs in the membership of the city planning board, the vacancy shall be filled forthwith by the council for the unexpired term.’
