STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Payments by Town of York to York Beach Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P. & S. L., 1901, c. 455, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of chapter 455 of the private and special laws of 1901, as repealed and replaced by chapter 167 of the private and special laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:

'The Town of York shall appropriate and pay over to the Treasurer of the York Beach Village Corporation, on or before the first day of July annually, commencing in 1956, out of taxes collected from the inhabitants and estates of said corporation, a sum of money computed as follows: From the annual appropriation raised by the town taxation on the estates and polls, and from moneys collected on excise taxes within the limits of said York Beach Village Corporation for the previous year, there shall be determined a sum of money equal to 35% 60% thereof, and said sum, so computed and determined, shall be the amount paid over to the said Corporation annually, as herein provided.'
