IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor in Hotels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows.

R. S., c. 61, § 47-A, additional. Chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 47-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 47-A. Sale of liquor in hotels. All rooms in licensed hotels open to the public where liquor is sold or served shall be equipped with tables, counters or booths and liquor may be served to or consumed by any person in said rooms whether sitting at such tables, counters or booths, or not.'
