STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing and Hunting Licenses for Nonresident Students in Maine Colleges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 39, sub-§ XII-C, additional. Section 39 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection to be numbered XII-C, to read as follows:

'XII-C. A license to hunt or fish shall be issued, at the resident license fee, to any nonresident student attending any college or university in this State authorized to confer degrees. Nonresident students, desiring a hunting or fishing license, must present certification from a dean of said college or university, that the person mentioned in the certification is enrolled at said college or university as a bona fide student.

Licenses may be issued by the clerk of the municipality in which said college or university is situated.

Holders of such licenses shall be subject to all the laws of the State and the rules and regulations of the commissioner regulating hunting and fishing, and for violations of said laws or rules and regulations, such license shall be revoked in the same manner as provided in this chapter for the revocation of hunting and fishing licenses.'
