

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Pension for Members of Police and Fire Departments of City of Waterville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1941, c. 88, §§ 12 and 13, additional. Chapter 88 of the private and special laws of 1941, as amended, is further amended by adding 2 new sections, to be numbered 12 and 13, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 12. Application. The foregoing sections shall not apply to any person who becomes a regular member of the police and fire departments after December 31, 1959.
- Sec. 13. Waiver. Any regular member of the police and fire departments, entitled to the benefits of the foregoing sections, shall have the right to waive such benefits, provided the City of Waterville procures for such person coverage under the Maine State Retirement System, and provided further that the City of Waterville shall apply all the funds such person has paid into the pension fund towards an equivalent retirement coverage under the Maine State Retirement System.'
