STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Occupational Diseases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 31, § 59 amended. Section 59 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 59. Definition of "occupational disease". Whenever used in this law, the term "occupational disease" shall be construed to mean only a any disease set forth in section 69 which is due to causes and conditions which are characteristic of and peculiar to a particular trade, occupation, process or employment and which arises arise out of and in the course of employment.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 31, § 69, repealed. Section 69 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 295 and by section 1 of chapter 391, both of the public laws of 1955, is repealed.
