STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Awarding Contracts for State Construction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15-A, § 28-A, additional. Chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding thereto a new section 28-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 28-A. Work performed for contractor. Any person to whom a contract for any public improvement has been awarded shall not sublet work under the contract to an amount greater than 75% of the total contract price. Every contract awarded under this chapter shall contain a provision in accordance with this section.'
