**AN ACT Relating to Rulings on Admissibility of Evidence by
Public Utility Hearing Examiners.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 44, § 63, amended. The last 3 sentences of section 63 of chapter 44 of the Revised Statutes are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'When objection is made to the admissibility of evidence, the examiners shall rule on the admissibility of the evidence in accordance with the practice and rules of evidence in civil actions in the Superior Court. The commission shall fix the salary of said examiners.'
