AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Jury Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 116, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. Salaries of jury commissioners. The jury commissioners for the several counties shall each receive for their services the following sums per year, and expenses ~~viz~~: Androscoggin, ~~\$100~~ \$150; Aroostook, ~~\$75~~ \$100; Cumberland, ~~\$125~~ \$250; Franklin, ~~\$50~~ \$75; Hancock, ~~\$50~~ \$75; Kennebec, \$100; Knox, ~~\$50~~ \$75; Lincoln, \$50; Oxford, ~~\$50~~ \$75; Penobscot, \$100; Piscataquis, \$50; Sagadahoc, ~~\$50~~ \$75; Somerset, ~~\$50~~ \$75; Waldo, ~~\$50~~ \$75; Washington, ~~\$50~~ \$75; York, ~~\$50~~ \$100.

Said salaries shall be paid by the respective counties in quarterly payments on the last day of each quarter, and their expenses shall be paid from time to time by the respective counties on bills approved by a Justice of the Superior Court.'
