STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Uniforms for Deputy Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 151, amended. The last sentence of section 151 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Upon approval of the county commissioners, uniforms required by this section, but not exceeding 24 for any one county, shall be furnished by the county.'
