STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Permitting the Town of Freeport to Provide Educational Scholarships.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town of Freeport to provide scholarships. The Town of Freeport may raise or appropriate money for the purpose of providing one-year tuition scholarships to worthy resident secondary school graduates of the Town of Freeport who have gained admission to any Maine college or university, said scholarships not to exceed the annual tuition charge to the University of Maine in the curriculum to which the recipient is admitted.

Said scholarships shall be awarded by a committee composed of the secondary school principal, the superintendent of schools, the members of the superintending school committee, the municipal officers, and one additional professional employee of the school department designated by the superintendent of schools, all of the Town of Freeport.

In the event that no qualified applicant shall apply the scholarship fund shall continue until awarded.

The treasurer of the Town of Freeport shall have custody of the scholarship fund. Payment shall be made directly to the institution upon receipt of a properly avouched invoice for tuition.
