AN ACT Relating to Cancellation of Automobile Physical Damage Insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 60, § 115-A, additional. Chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 115-A, to read as follows :

'Sec. 115-A. Cancellation of automobile physical damage insurance. An insurance company may cancel on ten days' written notice to the insured and any other person mentioned in the loss payable clause of the policy. When the policy is cancelled by the insured the insurance company shall notify forthwith any other person mentioned in the loss payable clause.'
