HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 931, L. D. 1317, Bill, "An Act to Create the Berwick Water and Sewerage District."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by adding at the end the following paragraph:

'The said district, for the purposes of its incorporation, is authorized to take and hold for public uses, by purchase, lease or the exercise of eminent domain or otherwise, any land or real estate or easement therein necessary, convenient and proper to accomplish the aforementioned powers and purposes of this act; and all such property, wherever the same shall be located, shall be exempt from taxation. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as authorizing said district to take by right of eminent domain any of the property or facilities of any other public service corporation or district used or acquired for future use by the owner thereof in the performance of a public duty, unless expressly authorized by subsequent act of the Legislature. Property shall be acquired by exercise of right of eminent domain when necessary as provided by the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 52, sections 23 to 27 and chapter 96, section 129.'
