# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Designating Certain Dermatitis Diseases as Occupational Diseases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 69, amended. Section 69 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 295 and by section 1 of chapter 391, both of the public laws of 1955, is further amended by adding at the end the following:

'13a. Dermatitis or pyodermia.

13a. Any process resulting in inflammation of the true skin or sensitive layer beneath the epidermis from the processing of poultry.'
