STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Chiropractic Treatment Under Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 9, amended. The first sentence of section 9 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'During the first 30 days after an injury aforesaid the employee shall be entitled to reasonable and proper medical, surgical and hospital services under the direction of a physician licensed by the Board of Registration of Medicine or the Board of Osteopathic Examination and Registration; nursing, medicines, and mechanical surgical aids when they are needed, and chiropractic treatment within the scope of their practice rights.'
