HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S. P. 472, L. D. 1337, Bill, "An Act
Establishing a Minimum Wage."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined paragraph
E of subsection III of section 132-B and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'E. Those employees of summer camps for boys or girls
under the age of 19 who are counselors or junior counselors;
employees regularly enrolled in an educational institution,
or are on vacation therefrom; or part-time worker working
no more than 24 hours per week for any one employer;'
