HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to S. P. 472, L. D. 1337, Bill, "An Act Establishing a Minimum Wage."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of paragraph E of subsection III of section 132-B and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

E. Any individual employed as a counselor or junior counselor in summer camps for boys and girls and those individuals who are regularly enrolled as students in an educational institution, or who are on vacation therefrom, or working part-time under 24 hours per week for one employer;
