SENATE AMENDMENT "F" to S. P. 472, L. D. 1337, Bill, "An Act  
Establishing a Minimum Wage."

Amend said Bill, in that part designated "Sec. 132-B",  
by striking out all of paragraph E of subsection III and inserting  
in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'E. Those employees of summer camps for boys or girls  
under the age of 19 who are counselors, or junior  
counselors; or who are regularly enrolled in an educational  
institution, or are on vacation therefrom;'
