HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 946, L. D. 1341, Bill, "An Act to Make Allocations from the General Highway Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1960 and June 30, 1961."

Amend said Bill under the caption "HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES" by striking out the line:

"State Aid (Special)	1,000,000	1,000,000"
and inserting in place thereof the line:		
'State Aid (Special)	1,000,000	-----'

Further amend said Bill by correcting the totals therein affected by the adoption of this amendment.

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 3, the following sections:

"Sec. 4. P. & S.L. 1959, c. 10, amended. Chapter 10 of the private and special laws of 1959 is amended to read as follows:

'Allocation for construction and reconstruction of state aid roads. From the income to the General Highway Fund for the next two fiscal years, from July 1, 1959 to June 30, 1960, and from July 1, 1960 to June 30, 1961, shall be segregated, apportioned and expended for:

Construction and Reconstruction of State Aid	\$2,000,000	\$2,000,000
Roads		<u>\$3,000,000'</u>

Sec. 5. R. S., c. 23, §44, amended. The second paragraph of section 44 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 20 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'Towns having a valuation of \$400,000 or less may appropriate any amount not exceeding ~~\$300~~ \$450; towns having a valuation of over \$400,000 and not over \$1,600,000 may appropriate any amount not exceeding ~~\$533~~ \$800; towns having a valuation of over \$1,600,000 and not over \$2,000,000 may appropriate an amount not exceeding ~~\$600~~ \$900; and towns having a valuation of over \$2,000,000 and not over ~~\$6,000,000~~ may appropriate in addition to the sum of ~~\$600~~ \$900 an additional sum of ~~\$66~~ \$100 for each \$400,000 or fraction thereof valuation in excess of ~~\$2,000,000~~; towns having a valuation of over \$6,000,000 and not over \$8,000,000 may appropriate not exceeding ~~\$1,333~~ \$2,000; and towns having a valuation of over \$8,000,000 may appropriate in addition to the sum of ~~\$1,333~~ \$2,000 an additional sum not exceeding ~~\$133~~ \$200 for each additional \$2,000,000 or fraction thereof of additional valuation.'

Sec. 6. R. S., c. 23, §51, amended. Section 51 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 51. Additional state aid for reconstruction. If any town shall expend a portion or all of its state aid joint fund as provided by sections 44, 46, 49 and 50 for reconstruction of improved state or state aid highways, the commission shall increase its apportionment of state aid by 20% 25% of the state aid joint fund so expended.'"
