HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 967, L. D. 1373, Bill, "An Act Amending the Maine Housing Authorities Act."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the single quotation mark the following:

'After a petition for a referendum to enable an authority to enter into any contract for loans, grants, contributions or other financial assistance with the Federal Government has been duly initiated in any city with a population of 50,000 or over and the majority of those voting, having voted in favor thereof, it shall not be compulsory to hold additional referenda on subsequent projects.'
