STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 99th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 967, L. D. 1373, Bill, "An Act Amending

the Maine Housing Authorities Act."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'It is the purpose and intent of this chapter to authorize every authority to do any and all things necessary or desirable to secure the financial aid or cooperation of the Federal Government in the undertaking, construction, maintenance or operation of any project by such authority;-provided;-however;-that-no.

No authority of any city shall enter into any contract for loans, grants, contributions or other financial assistance with the Federal Government fer-any-preject-unless-or until the-governing body-of-its-eity,-after a majority of the voters of the city voting in a referendum duly held thereon,-and-a-majority-of-the-voters voting-having have voted in favor thereof,-or of the question:
"Do you favor the development of approximately ----- dwelling units of low-rent housing for persons of low income to be constructed in the area within the territorial boundaries of the city for which the housing authority of the city may enter into agreements or contracts with the Federal Government for loans, grants, contributions or other financial assistance?"

The number of dwelling units and the location to be inserted in the proposed question shall be determined by appropriate resolution of the authority which shall furnish the city clerk with a copy thereof. The governing body shall authorize and make the necessary provisions for the holding of said referendum on a date no later than 60 calendar days from the receipt of said resolution by the city clerk. No authority of any city or town shall enter into any contract for loans, grants, contributions or other financial assistance with the Federal Government unless or until the governing body of a city or the annual meeting of its town, as the case may be, shall, by resolution duly adopted, have approved its entering-inte such-centract-prior-to-April-1,-1961 application to the Federal Government for such financial assistance.
