Proposed SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 200, L. D. 539, Bill, "An Act to Authorize General Fund Bond Issue in Amount of Ten Million Dollars to Provide Major Repairs, Construction and Equipment."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by striking out the words "Ten Million Dollars to Provide Major Repairs, Construction and Equipment" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Five Million Five Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars and to Appropriate Moneys for Capital Improvements, Construction, Repairs, Equipment, Supplies and Furnishings for Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1960 and June 30, 1961'

Further amend said Bill, in the 4th line, by striking out the words "major repairs, construction and equipment" and inserting in place thereof the words 'construction, repairs, equipment, supplies and furnishings.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the headnote of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'CHAPTER A

Sec. 1. Issue of bonds to provide for construction, repairs, equipment, supplies and furnishings.'

Further amend said Bill, in the 4th line of section 1, by striking out the figure "\$10,000,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$5,550,000'; and by striking out, in the 4th, 5th and 6th lines, the words and punctuation "major repairs, construction and equipment as may be authorized by the Legislature" and inserting in place thereof the words 'construction, repairs, equipment, supplies and furnishings, as authorized by section 6'

Further amend said Bill, in section 3, by adding after the words "set forth in" in the 7th line, the words 'Chapter A of'

Further amend said Bill, in section 4, by adding after the words "the provisions of" in the 2nd line, the words 'Chapter A of'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 5 thereof, the following:

Further amend said Bill, in section 6, by striking out the figure and word "5 of" in the 2nd line and inserting in place thereof the figure and words '6 of Chapter A of'; and by inserting after the words "forth in" in the 4th line the words 'Chapter A of'

Further amend said Bill, in section 7, by inserting after the words "or rejection of" in the 8th line the words 'Chapter A of'; and by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph relating to the question and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Shall a bond issue be ratified for the purposes set forth in 'An Act to Authorize General Fund Bond Issue in Amount of Five Million Five Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars and to Appropriate Moneys for Capital Improvements, Construction, Repairs, Equipment, Supplies and Furnishings for Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1960 and June 30, 1961,' passed by the 99th Legislature?"

Further amend said Bill, in section 7, by inserting after the words "in favor of" in the 21st line, the words 'Chapter A of'; and by inserting after the word "and" in the 23rd line, the words 'Chapter A of'; and by inserting after the words "in conformity with" in the 27th line, the words 'Chapter A of'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 6 and 7 to be sections 7 and 8.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

CHAPTER B

Sec. 1. Appropriations for necessary expenditures of State Government.

In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of State Government for the next two fiscal years—from July 1, 1959 to June 30, 1960, and from July 1, 1960 to June 30, 1961—the following sums or as much thereof as shall be found necessary, as designated in the following tabulations, are hereby appropriated for construction, repairs, equipment, supplies and furnishings out of any moneys in the General Fund Unappropriated Surplus not otherwise appropriated. It is the intent of the Legislature that the items listed below shall be reconsidered by the Governor and Council on recommendation of the various department heads and that the appropriation to each department or institution shall be used to meet the most urgent needs at that time. Upon receipt of allotments duly approved by the Governor and Council based upon work programs submitted to the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, the State Controller shall authorize expenditures of these appropriations and revenues accruing thereto, on the basis of such allotments and not otherwise.

Any balances at June 30, 1960 shall not lapse but shall be carried forward into the following year to be expended for the same purposes. Any unencumbered balances at June 30, 1961 shall lapse unless sufficient evidence in the form of encumbrances is filed with the State Controller prior to June 30, 1961, showing that the project is in process, in which case all moneys appropriated to the project shall be carried to the following years to be expended for the same purpose until such project is completed, unless otherwise directed by the Legislature.
