STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY

AN ACT to Authorize the Municipalities of North Yarmouth and Pownal to Form a School Administrative District and Contract with the Town of Cumberland for High School Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

School Administrative District for North Yarmouth and Pownal authorized; date limitation. The Maine School District Commission is hereby authorized to approve the formation of a school administrative district composed of the Towns of North Yarmouth and Pownal. Said district shall contract, pursuant to the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 41, section 111-E-1, with the Town of Cumberland for the education of high school pupils. These municipalities are exempted from the limitations provided in the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 41, section 111-E, as amended, and the Maine School District Commission is authorized to proceed pursuant to sections 111-E-1 to 111-U of said chapter 41.

The authority granted in this act shall not extend beyond December 31, 1960.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bill temporarily permits the municipalities to form a district because at the present time they do not have enough students to meet the minimum requirements of law. After December 1, 1960 there will be enough students and this bill gives the municipalities a chance to form a district before December 1, 1960.
