**RESOLVE, Providing for Decrease in Retirement Benefit for Helen D. Perry  
of Rockland.**

**Helen D. Perry; retirement benefit decreased. Resolved:** That the retirement benefit now being paid to Helen D. Perry of Rockland, under the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, be decreased from \$1,404 per year to \$1,380 per year, to be retroactive to January 1, 1960.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the regular session of the 99th Legislature an increase in benefit payments for Helen D. Perry was granted, to the amount of \$1,404 per year. It was not realized at the time that the granting of this amount of benefit from the State would jeopardize the relatively small amount of benefit she is receiving from the Veterans Administration. The purpose of this resolve is to correct that inequity and establish a state benefit that will conform to the provisions of federal law.
