IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Authorizing Governor and Council to Sell or Lease Western Maine Sanatorium.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sale or lease of Western Maine Sanatorium. The Governor and Council may lease or sell on behalf of the State the interests of the State in the property at Western Maine Sanatorium in Hebron. The proceeds of such sales or leases shall be credited to the General Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Western Maine Sanatorium has been discontinued and the property is no longer needed by the State. This act proposes that the Governor and Council either lease or sell the property and thus realize financial gain to the State for property that is not being utilized.
