### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY

AN ACT Relating to Municipal Police Power to Transport School Children to Other Than Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 90-A, § 3, sub-§ VI, additional. Section 3 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection VI to read as follows:
  - 'VI. School transportation. Providing for the transportation of school children to and from schools other than public schools, except such schools as are operated for profit in whole or in part.'

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose of the bill is to give to municipalities the police power to transport school children to other than public schools without state subsidy.
