HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 6, Joint Order Relative to Assignment of Rooms for Hearings."

Amend said Order by inserting after the word "Building" in the fourth line thereof the words 'and State Office Building'.

Further amend said Order by adding at the end thereof the following:

'and be it Further Ordered, the House concurring, that
Room 135 be assigned to the minority party for use as a caucus
room; said minority party to have the exclusive control of said
Room 135 at all times except when assigned for a committee hearing.'
