CHAPTER XXXIV.

Resolve directing the Valuation Committee. *June 23th, 1820.*

Resolved, That in all questions which may be decided by the Committee on the Valuation, appointed this day, no county shall be entitled to a greater number of votes than said county is entitled to, at the Senate Board of this State.

CHAPTER XXXV.

Resolve correcting an error in the Pay Roll. *June 23th, 1820.*

WHEREAS an error of two hundred and twenty-five dollars has occurred, in stating the amount of travel and attendance of the Members of the House of Representatives on their Pay Roll, which has passed the Legislature this day in consequence of the omission to cast up the travel and attendance of four members, made up on a separate page in said Pay Roll: Therefore,

Resolved, That the aforesaid sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars be added to the amount stated on said Roll, to correct the mistake above mentioned.
