CHAPTER CCV.

AN ACT allowing additional pay to the Attorney General,

Salary increased. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That there be allowed and paid out of the public Treasury, in quarterly payments, commencing on the first of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twentytwo, to the Attorney General of the State, two hundred dollars per annum, in addition to the sum already authorized by law to be paid to that officer. [This Act passed February 9, 1822.]

CHAPTER CCVI.

AN ACT to alter the time of holding the Court of Sessions in the County of Washington.

B_E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the term of the Court of Sessions for the County of Washington, which is now by law to be held on the first 'Tuesday of September annually, shall, from and after the passing of this Act, be held on the third Tuesday of September annually, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
